Our children also got admitted in Hawthorn schools: Sonam in Jr. High; Neema in Middle School; and Joshua in Elementary North. Their classes have begun from August 23 and they all seem to be pleased with their new teachers. Please continue to pray for our children as they adjust to the new schools.

Since Asangla could not find a job, looking to God in faith for all our needs, we decided that she should pursue MA in Counseling & Psychology at Trinity. This degree will enable her to be a licensed practitioner. We are glad to inform you that she has been accepted into the program beginning this Fall. She does not have any scholarship; however, being a spouse of a student she will get 50% discount on her tuition. Please pray that the Lord will meet all our needs and enable Asangla to fulfill her heart's desire.

In the month of July A.K. lost his oldest brother in India. He was a Buddhist. AK could not go for his funeral. His brother's grieving wife and two children do not know the Lord and thus desperately need our prayers.

As we equip ourselves for the benefit of our future ministry in India we continue to seek your prayers for us. We deeply appreciate and value your love and prayers for our family. We are grateful to God for He has met many of our financial and other needs again and again through His faithful people.
