Land Development Update: The wall construction is done. A small fish pond has been built as an income generation project of TLA-ET. Labor camp is set up for the laborers as the construction of TLA Training Centre is about to start soon.

Updates from HFC (January– March 2021)

Update on the Second Worship Shed project in Bihar: The first worship shed is complete and we thank the donors for sacrificially contributing towards it. Around 60 new believers are meeting in that shed every Sunday and worshipping the Lord. The second Worship Shed (the larger project) has started in Chitorkhar, Jehanabad District, Bihar and around 300 new believers who embraced Christ in recent years will be worshipping in this shed. Motorbike Project: TLA has donated 60 bikes till 2020. We have started following them up on their bike status and ministry updates. Some of them reported that this means of conveyance has been a great help to them and their ministry.

One of the beneficiaries Mr. Deori from Arunachal Pradesh commented, "As motorbike is an utmost ministry need for conveyance, God answered my prayers when TLA provided me a motorcycle in the year 2006. It was and still is an immense help for my work. It has been my legs since then and I dearly maintain and take care of it. It's been 16 long years but still it is in very good running condition. I do not have enough words to thank Dr. A. K. Lama for his thoughtfulness, burden and prayers to raise support and minister to men and women who face many challenges in their service of the communities. Thank you and God bless!"

This year, on March 9 HFC could reach out to seven Community Development Workers (CDWs) from



Jehanabad, Bihar and could help them by donating 4 Motorbikes and 3 Bicycles. The CDWs had difficulty to go to the communities that they are serving, as, public transportations are not reliable in their areas. They have to walk several miles to reach their destination.

Tailoring Training Centre: On March 8, HFC inaugurated the

new project "Tailoring Training Centre" in Six Mile, Guwahati, Assam. This project intends to provide basic skills in tailoring for three months to destitute and marginalized women living in the neighborhood. Dr. Asangla Ao, President of HFC inaugurated the Centre and Dr. A. K Lama, Treasurer of HFC prayed for the trainees and the new Centre.
