Updates from TLA-ET

Update on Land Development:

- i. The TLA Training Center construction works is progressing. The left wing is nearing to complete. The Building Committee members visited the site on March 4.

Motorbike Distribution of the TLA-ET:

This is a project of TLA-ET started in 2006 to distribute bikes to pastors and evangelists who face inconvenience in traveling while working with far flung communities. Till date, 60+ pastors and evangelists received Motorbikes. One of the recipients of the year 2019 shares his acknowledgment and gratitude.

Dorjee Dupir, who is helping Bible Translation works in one of the tribal dialects that does not have any portion of the Bible, writes: *"It was hard for me to do God's ministry as I used to walk from my village through the forest for several days to reach another village. I always take shortest way which takes two days to cross the mountains. But now it takes only 4 to 5 hours to reach another village by bike. I am thankful to God and TLA-ET ministry for their concern and support towards us. Many souls are touched because I could be in the place where the word of God was needed. I am happy and I would request you to pray for my ongoing ministry".*

Tailoring Training Centre: 12 trainees have successfully completed a basic training in Tailoring. On March 15, they were given a certificate of completion. Mr. Siamliana Khiangte, Secretary HFC, encouraged them with a short message.

The same month, out of 28 new applicants, 20 women were selected and their training started from March 16.

New House Prayer Groups/ Cottage Meeting: Rejoice with us as 6 new Cottage meetings could be started at Dumri, Panditpur, Salempur Kodihara Paibigha and Masaudi in Jehanabad district of Bihar. Around 35-40 people are attending now. It is led by our staffs.

Pastors and Leaders Meeting: A two days training was held (March 8-9) in Dhanbad, Jharkhand. Around 15-20 people attended. The sessions were on **“Calling”** and **“Personal Bible study”**. The participants were blessed as some of them came from other faith and had never attended this type of training before.
